

PRIVACY NOTICE

DATA CONTROLLER

The controller of the personal data you provided in the form is Grupa OLX sp. z o.o. with its registered seat in Poznań, ul. Królowej Jadwigi 43 (hereinafter referred to as the "Controller"). The Controller decides on the purposes and means of processing your data. If you have any questions or requests regarding your personal data, you can contact the Controller:

PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASIS FOR PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The Controller processes your personal data (first name and surname, business e-mail address in the OLX domain, accommodation-related information, and your expectations regarding the Event) on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council ("GDPR"). The Controller's legitimate interest consists in verifying your registration, further contact with you, enabling you to take part in the Event, and ensuring its organisational and logistical handling (including accommodation).

Any person who correctly completes the registration form in accordance with the Terms & Conditions is entitled to take part in the Event. Your data will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling. Detailed rules on the processing of personal data can also be found in the Terms & Conditions.

VOLUNTARY PROVISION OF DATA

Providing your personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary in order to verify your registration, maintain further contact with you, enable you to take part in the Event, and ensure its organisational and logistical handling.

DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The personal data provided in the form will be processed for the purpose specified above until you object to their processing (in accordance with the "Your rights" section below), but no longer than:

- **until October 17, 2026** (i.e., until the end of the Event and the settlement of the organisational matters related to it).

DATA RECIPIENTS AND DATA TRANSFERS TO THIRD COUNTRIES

Only employees and associates of the Controller who are authorised to do so have access to your personal data. For the purposes specified above, the Controller entrusts the processing of your personal data to the event agency co-organising the Event and administering the registration page, as well as to IT and technology-support service providers.

The recipients of your data may also include public authorities entitled to receive it under the law (e.g. courts, public prosecutors, tax authorities).

Your data will not be transferred to third countries (i.e. countries outside the European Economic Area) or to international organisations.

YOUR RIGHTS

As the processing of your personal data takes place, you have the right to make the following requests:

- right of access to your data – at any time you may find out what data the Controller processes, obtain a copy of your data, and receive the information about such processing set out in the GDPR;
- right to rectification of your data – at any time you may request that your data be rectified or, to the extent necessary, completed;
- right to erasure of your data ("right to be forgotten") – to the extent set out in the GDPR, you may request that the Controller erase your data (e.g. where you raise a justified objection to the processing of your data);
- right to restriction of processing of your data – to the extent set out in the GDPR, you may request that your data be processed only in a restricted manner (e.g. where you object to the processing of your data – for the period during which the Controller verifies whether the objection is justified);
- right to data portability – i.e. to receive your data in a machine-readable format and to have it transmitted to another entity indicated by you, unless doing so would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others;
- right to object to the processing of your data – in which case the Controller will no longer be permitted to process such personal data, unless we demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the continued processing which override your interests, rights and freedoms, or grounds for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims;
- right to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out by the Controller before its withdrawal;
- right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych) – if you consider that your data protection rights have been infringed.

Please note that the precise scope of the rights available to you, together with their limitations, is set out in the GDPR, in Chapter III.
